



Information Security Policy

Ölgerðin is committed to maximizing the security of the company's, employees', and customers' information with regard to confidentiality, integrity, and availability.

Ölgerðin promotes active security awareness, including through educational materials for employees.

Ölgerðin works on continuous improvement and identifies opportunities and risks regarding information security.

Ölgerðin promotes active education on information security, and all employees participate in protecting data and information systems against unauthorized access, use, modification, disclosure, destruction, loss, or transfer.

Ölgerðin works with reliable data; users have easy and secure access to the information and services that they need at any given time.

Ölgerðin has an active system that monitors cyberattacks and establishes security rules to prevent them. All employees have a role in helping to prevent cyberattacks:

- Never click links or attachments from an unknown sender, a sender who does not usually send you links, or links that appear suspicious.
- Use strong passwords and never disclose them.
